Diana Mohyi report

Diana Mohyi, the NY lawyer, reported on the following:

Diana showed how we can search the IRS charity search feature to find our organization is now listed as a 501C-3.

We also have now been approved as a State of NY charity. Diana formed us that we need to fill out the CHAR 500 form with the State of New York annually by May 15. We also need to file an E-990 with the IRS each year. Cara will be responsible for E-990 with the IRS each year. The chair or another officer can fill out CHAR 500 form. It will need to be completed with the appropriate IRS 990 form. There is no fee to file the CHAR 500 because our donations are low enough that we are exempt. For NY charities, proper contact information is most important. We may wish to amend our form each year when leadership changes.

The journals going online is a continued project. The new Anorexia 8-9 pamphlet has been submitted, and a new Anorexia 10-11-12 pamphlet is being prepared.

On the Service Forum, SLAA is soliciting feedback on a new version of the basic text. There is a new general release form for recordings of speakers at qualifications. There is a strong Healthy Relationships Discussion group on WhatsApp.

Business for next month


Cara will present her findings from the accountant to clarify our tax filing situation from the past few years.
